They, along with over 287 other cars turned numerous laps, in preparation for the event, and each were also winners in the Mopar Trivia Challenge, picking up a Mopar Pride Pak. These two drivers answered all five questions correctly on the entry form at the Mopar display, which is located just off the main straight-away of the race course, set up at the famed Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Siegel, who calls New Albany, Ohio home, was the morning winner, while Dale, who hails from Murietta, California, was the afternoon victor. Each day there will be two Mopar Trivia Challenge drawings, one in the morning and
